### Practical Information

New Delhi and Gurgaon, are neighbouring interconnected cities in the National Capital Region (NCR).

#### **Transfer to Hotel:**

We have organized transfer of all delegates to Hotel Pullman from the Indira Gandhi International Airport-Terminal 3. Please look for a representative holding the ITF Logo who will be able to assist you and direct you to the transport. **Climate** in Delhi/Gurgaon at this time of the year will have temperatures ranging between 8 - 20 deg C, with spells of sunny, windy and cloudy weather conditions. Since early mornings and evenings can be cooler, it is advised to carry a jacket when venturing out.

**Currency/Money:** Indian Rupees. Denominations of 1000, 500, 100, 50, 20, 10 in notes and coins 10, 5,2,1  
Rs. 1 = 100 paisa (USD 1 = Rs. 60 approx)

**Transportation:** Commonly Metro is the best way to commute between New Delhi and Gurgaon. The nearest Metro station to Hotel Pullman is 'Guru Dronacharya' which is about 7-8 minutes walk from the hotel. Autorickshaws are easily available at all metro stations. Auto fare from Guru Dronacharya metro station to hotel Pullman should be Rs. 50. / Radio Taxis are available by calling: Meru Cabs - 44 22 44 22 , Easy Cabs - 43 43 43 43.

**Communication:** As you come out of the Indira Gandhi International Airport Terminal 3, please look out for the following kiosks to purchase a local SIM card.

**Aircel** – Next to Taxi Stands at Arrival Lounge

**Airtel** – Next to Costa Coffee Counter at Arrival Lounge

**Wi-fi:** Free wi-fi is available at the hotel for each room. The password will be given at the time of your check-in.

**Banking facilities/ATMs:**

Bank timings are normally between 0900 -1800 hours. The hotel concierge should help you with locations of banks in the vicinity. While ATMs are available in all Malls, the closest is available at the Guru Dronacharya Metro Station.

**Medical**

Though there will be a doctor on call available at Hotel Pullman, there are plenty of hospitals and nursing homes in Gurgaon, the closest one being Neelkanth Hospital at DLF Phase II (about 10 min drive from the hotel Pullman)

**Personal Safety:**

As a matter of precaution, travellers should be vigilant and alert at all times and it is recommended that participants travel in small groups and use authorized radio taxi services or from the hotel. In case of need you may also contact ITF Delhi Office staff for assistance.

**Personal dressing:**

It is advised that women should take dressing precautions especially if you are going out late evenings/dinners. Smart casual dressing is advised.

**Water** : Water served in Pullman Hotel & its restaurants is safe. Please use bottled Mineral water when stepping out of hotel.

**Sight Seeing:**

Kuoni / Sita Travels will be setting up a desk at the hotel Pullman lobby. Please contact them for sightseeing or other travel requirements etc. This desk will also be collecting payments from all the self paying participants of the Conference.

**Rally:**

A Women's Rally on Violence Against Women has been organized on 28<sup>th</sup> January from 15.15–17.00 hours. Buses from the Pullman Hotel will depart at 1430 hours to go to State Entry Road, New Delhi (venue of the rally).
